



Darpariaeth CDD/ PDG Provision

Ysgol Gymraeg Abercynon

Mae'r grant Grant CDD yn arian ychwanegol a roddir i ysgolion i gefnogi disgyblion a all fod neu wedi bod dan anfantaes oherwydd statws economaidd neu sy'n derbyn gofal/mewn gofal

The PDG grant is additional monies given to schools to support pupils who are or may have been disadvantaged due to economic status or being looked after/in care.

Yn Ysgol Abercynon ein blaenoriaethau yw:

- Cyflogi staff er mwyn cefnogi ein plant bregus.
- Darparu gweithgareddau/ prosiectau creadigol gyda'r disgyblion gan ddilyn eu diddordebau
- Cyflogi staff er mwyn darparu ymyraethau a chefnogaeth medrau sylfaenol i ddisgyblion CDD er mwyn iddynt derbyn cefnogaeth bwrpasol yn ei medrau, llythrennedd, rhifedd a Lles.

At Ysgol Abercynon our Priorities are:

- Employ staff to support our vulnerable children.
- Provide creative activities/ projects with pupils interests at the center
- Employ staff to provide interventions and basic skills support to CDD pupils so that they can receive dedicated support in her skills, literacy, numeracy and Wellbeing.

Asesu a thracio - Athrawon yn asesu a thracio cynnydd disgyblion trwy adnodd Cerrig Croesi, data asesiadau mewnol a siarad a dygwyr er mwyn sicrhau addysg o radd uchaf.

Adnoddau - adnoddau wedi prynu i gefnogi dysgu ac addysgu meysydd craidd.

ELSA Sessions - CWTSH CYNON

Hafan Cynon - 2 Level 3 teaching assistants offering 50% Language, numeracy and wellbeing sessions. Our intention will be for CDD pupils to make good progress in their key skills

Assessment and tracking - Teachers assess and track pupils' progress through the Cerrig Croesi tool, internal assessment data and speaking and learners, this will ensure an effective education.

Resources - resources purchased to support learning and teaching core areas.

Fruit shop - Fruit available during play time

Extra-Curricular Clubs - A range of extra-curricular activities for students to join.

Y Gymuned/The Community:

Rydym yn bwriadu cynnal cyfres o weithdai i rieni, megis sesiynau ymwybyddiaeth ADHD, i ddarparu gwybodaeth ymarferol a chynyddu dealltwriaeth o anghenion gwahanol y plant. Bydd hyn yn cryfhau ymgysylltiad rhieni a chymuned yr ysgol, ac yn y pen draw yn cyfrannu at well cefnogaeth a lles disgyblion.

Gwella presenoldeb ysgol gyfan yn ogystal a grwpiau o ddisgyblion. - Mae presenoldeb yn parhau i fod yn darged Ysgol a Chlwstwr.

Cefnogaeth arianol i deuluoedd bregus (lle bo angen) -

Disgyblion CCD wedi derbyn cymorth arianol, cymorth i dalu dros amser fel eu bod yn gallu matesio'n llawn ar brofiadau allgyrsiol e.e Llangrannog a Glan Llyn.

We intend to run a series of parent workshops, such as ADHD awareness sessions, to offer practical information and increase understanding of pupils' diverse needs. This will strengthen parental and school community engagement, ultimately leading to improved support and wellbeing for our learners.

Improve school-wide attendance as well as groups of pupils. - Attendance remains a School and Cluster target.

Monetary support for vulnerable families (where necessary) - CCD pupils have received cash support, payment support over time so they can join extra-curricular experiences e.g Glan Llyn.
